

2020 Track and Event Rules

- Driver's meetings are **mandatory** for all drivers.
- Classroom and in-car exercises are **mandatory** for all "Yellow" NOVICE group students.
- Absolutely no alcohol consumption is allowed until the track closes for the day.
- No motor vehicles are allowed on the track before the track opens and after it closes each day.
- This is not a racing school or a drifting competition.
- Only instructors are allowed as passengers in a student's car.
- All school entrants are free to ride as a passenger in an **INSTRUCTOR'S** car at any time, with priority given to the instructor's student(s). Any non-entrant wanting a ride must register as a rider and must sign the appropriate waivers. Only **selected & approved** Instructors may give rides to non-entrants.
- Passing cars will always overtake on the left, and **ONLY** in designated zones and **AFTER** receiving an appropriate passing signal. The passing signal is to turn on your right turn signal and move to the right. After the pass is complete, use your left turn signal to indicate you are moving back on line. **NOTE:** Passing is **ALWAYS** a cooperative exercise! **LIFT** so the person passing can safely make the pass before the braking zone! Just like street driving protocol!
- If you experience two or more wheels off-track or spinning on the track you must come into the hot pits for car check and discussion with the event organizers.
- Driver's side window must be all the way down. Passenger side window must be all the way down if a passenger is present, otherwise either all the way up or all the way down.
- Sunroofs must be completely closed. All loose items should be removed from the car.
- Speed limit in the paddock and access roads is 15 mph.
- Properly dispose of any used car fluids (brake, oil, coolant, etc.)
